Indivisible Chapters Throughout Arizona Congressional District 2 Endorse Jonathan Nez; Call for Ouster of Extremist Incumbent Eli Crane

FLAGSTAFF, AZ — Today, fifteen **Indivisible** groups in **Congressional District 2*** formally announced their endorsement of **Jonathan Nez** for the U.S. House of Representatives in Arizona's 2nd Congressional District. Following a comprehensive review of the candidates and a vote by our membership, Indivisible is committed to mobilizing our grassroots network to restore principled, effective leadership to Northern Arizona.

For too long, the people of CD2 have been subjected to the performative politics of **Eli Crane**. While our communities face pressing challenges—from water scarcity and forest health to the rising costs of housing and healthcare—Crane has consistently prioritized extremist rhetoric, and partisan obstructionism over the needs of his constituents. His complicity in supporting an illegal and immoral war has driven up the cost of gas and overall cost of living. His record of voting against critical infrastructure and his alignment with anti-democratic movements have left our district without a serious voice in Washington.

The Case for Jonathan Nez

In stark contrast to the current representation, Jonathan Nez offers a proven track record of servant leadership. As a former President of the Navajo Nation, Nez has demonstrated an ability to lead through crises with composure and a focus on the common good.

Indivisible groups in Arizona are endorsing Jonathan Nez because he is committed to:

- **Accountable Representation:** Unlike Eli Crane, who caters to a narrow ideological fringe, Jonathan Nez understands the diverse needs of CD2, from rural ranching communities to our vibrant tribal nations and urban centers.
- **Protecting Democratic Institutions:** While the incumbent has fueled election denialism, Nez stands firm in his commitment to protecting the right to vote and ensuring that our democratic processes remain secure and accessible to all.
- **Delivering Real Results:** Nez focuses on the issues that matter to Arizonans: climate resilience, water security, agriculture and economic dignity. He is a leader who seeks solutions rather than headlines.

“The choice for the 2nd District could not be clearer,” said Coconino County resident **Gary Resnick** of Indivisible Northern Arizona. “We can continue with the chaos, extremism and complicity of Eli Crane, or we can elect a proven leader in Jonathan Nez who will actually show up for work and fight for every family in Northern Arizona.
